The **Sunset Music and Education Foundation** (SMEF) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to using music as a catalyst for education, empowerment, and cultural connection. Founded as Sunset Music in 1985 and evolving into a nonprofit in 2025, SMEF carries more than 30 years of proven impact and community leadership.

To create a just and inclusive world where music connects generations, sparks learning, and opens doors to opportunity.

Our Mission

The Sunset Music and Education Foundation (SMEF) transforms lives through music and education. We produce world-class performances that amplify underrepresented voices, foster intergenerational learning, and create pathways to a brighter future for emerging artists and leaders.

Why It Matters

Our legacy is rooted in world-class performances that reflect the full spectrum of our shared humanity. Yet systemic inequities persist: according to the USC Annenberg Inclusion Initiative, Artists of color represent less than 20% of performers on mainstream stages, women account for only 23% of performing artists, and LGBTQ+ artists remain significantly underrepresented—SMEF directly addresses these gaps. We are here to change that onstage and off—by providing platforms, visibility, and resources to important historically excluded voices.

Youth Impact: The SMARTS Initiative

At the heart of our work, the SMARTS Initiative (Sharing Music, Accessing Resources, Transforming Students) equips underserved youth with instruments, mentorship, scholarships, and performance opportunities. In the Coachella Valley—where 94% face economic hardship—music access transforms lives, boosting academics, graduation rates, and nurturing tomorrow's cultural leaders.

→ SMEF's SMARTS Initiative bridges these gaps with instruments, mentorships, scholarships, and performance opportunities.

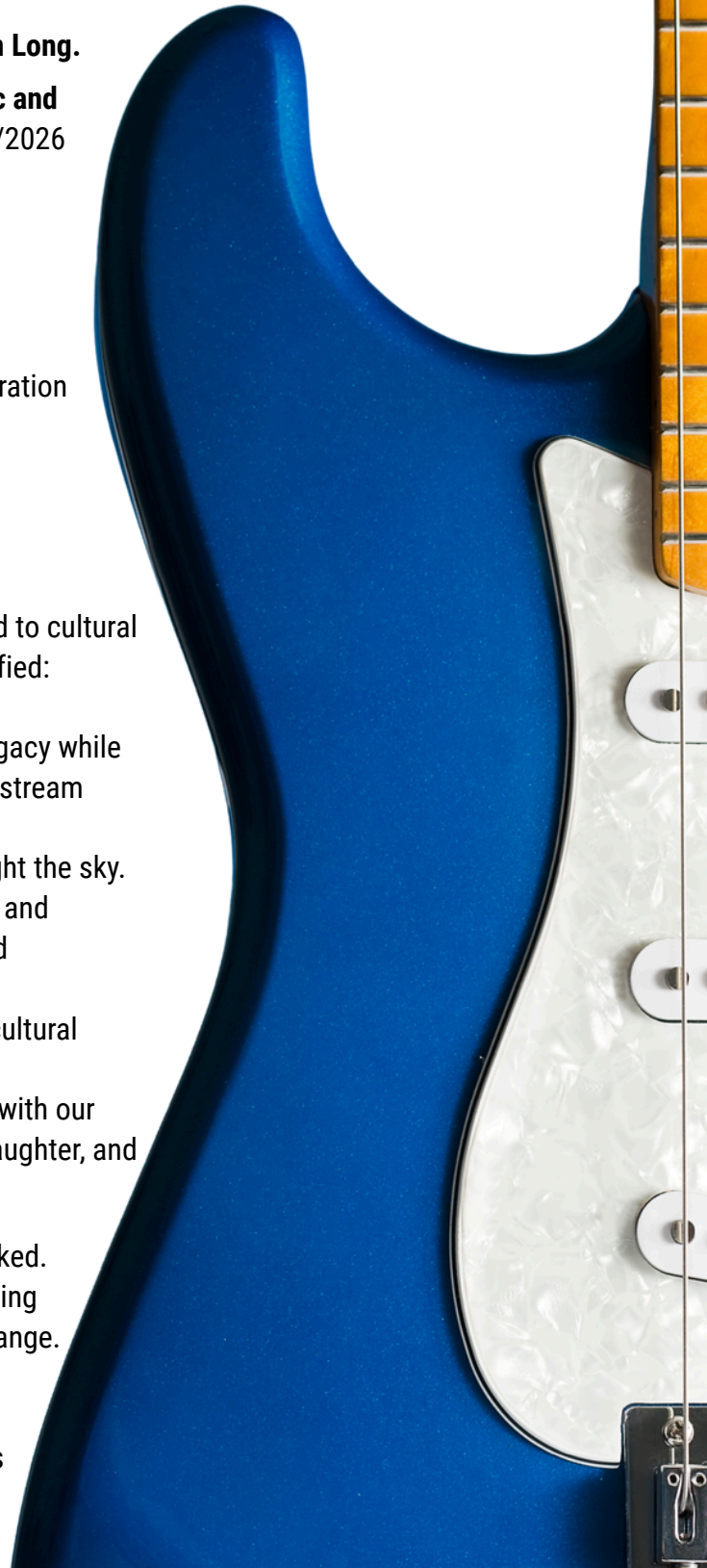
